Joe Jakubick, from First Energy, presented the Board with some information understanding rights-of-way and encroachments.

Trustee Daugherty discussed with the Board the possibility of an audio recording of the minutes to eliminate any misinterpretation. He will get some pricing and have it for the next meeting. He has been working with the Richland County Commissioners and they stated they may be able to fund the recorder for us.

Trustee Gleisinger presented the Board with a quote for a new mower in the amount of \$13,459.54 without trade-in value.

At 7:00 p.m. bid openings were held for the purchase of the Road Dept. tractor. FO Kochheiser opened the following bids for the 2005 John Deere 6320 tractor with alamo boom mower:

**Motion #77-2022:** Trustee Gleisinger made a motion to accept the bid of \$63,000 from Perry Township Trustees for the 2005 John Deere Tractor, seconded by Trustee Daugherty and upon a roll call vote all members voted "AYE."

**Motion #78-2022:** Trustee Gleisinger made a motion to purchase a new 4-wheel drive X758 John Deere Signature Series lawn tractor from Ag Pro in the amount of \$13,459.54, seconded by Trustee Daugherty and upon a roll call vote all members voted "AYE."

Small's Asphaltting measured the roads for the 2022 Chip and Seal Program. The roads are Flowers, Noblet, Lohr, Wittmer, and Snodgrass.

Trustee Gleisinger updated the Board on the road department. The mini excavator had some repairs done to the radiator and replaced some hose.

The Board agreed to put the road department's zero turn mower out for bid.

Trustee Rose has legally changed her name to Carns due to marriage.

FO Kochheiser presented the Board with a public records request and asked the Trustees to prepare their responses in a timely manner and email the records to her and she will respond on everyone's behalf.

Craig Hunt had a question regarding the mower that the Board will be putting out to bid. He wanted to know if the fire department could use it.

**Motion #79-2022:** Trustee Rose made a motion to go into Executive Session at 7:26 p.m. to discuss conferences with the Board's attorney to discuss matters which are the subject of pending or imminent court action. Trustee Gleisinger seconded the motion and upon a roll call all members voted "AYE".

**Motion #81-2022:** There being no further business to come before the Board, Trustee Daugherty made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Trustee Gleisinger, motion carried.
