Chief Spellman received an email from Kimora Wong as she is requesting sponsorship for \$1,622.00 for tuition for FFII class at Knox Career Center. This will be reimbursed to the township through a training grant. The Board approved this sponsorship,

Trustee Gleisinger updated the board on the Road Dept. They have been ditching on Bowers Rd., did a drive install on Springfield Circle, helped

Sandusky Township, as well as dug out for concrete work at the Road garage. The concrete work is now complete. They also installed a pipe at Wiles Estate.

The bill was received from Kokosing for the paving on Alta and Snodgrass and the surface tonnage and tack coat costs were lower, and we still came under the bid price. We saved \$8,900 and got the paving and butt joints covered under what was originally bid.

Motion #161-2025: Trustee Gleisinger moved to renew the township liability insurance with the Ohio Plan for 2026 in the amount of \$33,543.00, seconded by Trustee Daugherty, and upon a roll call vote all members voted "AYE."

Trustee Gleisinger also informed the board that the Richland County Commissioners, pursuant to HB 96, voted to enact the additional OCC (Owner Occupied Credit) and not to go forward with the Homestead exemption beginning in 2026 thus costing us \$24,422.07 instead of the original amount of \$88,693.57.

Our mechanic Vern Bickers recommended repairs to our back-up ambulance in the amount of \$9,879.28 @ Denny's Automotive and these repairs were approved and are underway. Ontario Truck Center was unable to get the work done in a timely manner.

Guest Jim Komives voiced a concern about the emergency ambulance getting repaired and was told he would have to wait until public comment to address his concerns.

Trustee Orewiler stated that Walker Lake Rd was tarred and chipped by the County and then they waited and fogged the road to seal and heal the road. We will watch to see how this fogging holds up and may consider this for future chip/seal work.

Trustee Orewiler contacted Pioneer School about the wall at Station that needs repaired. Instructor Grant Brockwell will be touching base with us soon to look at the repair and let us know if his students can do the work in the Spring of 2026.

Ramp up tones should be covered under a BWC Grant. The Fire Dept will look into this and apply for the Grant.

The road sign at Station #2 is not visible to traffic coming from the North and Trustee Orewiler would like to see some trees trimmed back so it can be more visible. It is set back due to the Water well junction box according to Trustee Daugherty. Trustee Orewiler hoped we could move a couple signs and sickle down some weeds or trim branches & will need to get with the County Engineer for the signs since this is a county road.

FO Kochheiser returned the Superior Dental renewal to the Board for their approval. This was discussed at the last meeting.

Motion #162-2025: Trustee Gleisinger moved to renew the MMO Superior Dental Group Dental Insurance Policy for 2026, in an annual amount of \$19,819.20, seconded by Trustee Orweiler, motion carried.

The 2026 Meeting dates and Payroll Schedules were then re-presented to the Board from the last meeting and the Board approved them both.

FO Kochheiser presented Motion #158-2021 regarding Cyber Security that she feels should be recalled due to the new Motion recently passed regarding

the same subject. Trustee Gleisinger will review it and bring it back to the next meeting.

FO Kochheiser informed the Board of the Christmas Dinner that the RCTA is hosting and asked for their attendance plans so she could RSVP.

Public Comment:

Kenn Spencer asked why the trustees made different salaries and wanted to know how much they were paid. FO Kochheiser advised him he was looking at their net pay not their gross amounts on the minutes and that they all make the same amount. He asked them what their salary was and none of them knew exactly. FO Kochheiser instructed him that all Ohio Township employees' salaries could be found online.

He asked if he could have a copy of the 2026 meeting schedule and FO Kochheiser advised him to make a public records request for it. He went on to state that residents have been asking him questions such as who takes the minutes, if the City of Ontario pays their fair share of the fire dept. and wanted to know if the Road Dept comes to the meetings. Also, he asked how the trustee voting goes and if the FO gets to vote. He also invited Chief and A/C to Leadership Unlimited classes.

Jim Komives again asked why the Board wouldn't get the ambulance checked over while it was in the shop.

Motion #163-2025: Trustee Orewiler made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Trustee Gleisinger, motion carried.
